- Other key donation persons

Profile of other key players (non - health care professionals):

- Patient support groups
- Communication officers of national/regional authorities and of healthcare establishments
- Key opinion leaders
- Journalists in the field of health

They will need to provide us with the following documents: CV, letter of support from the sending organization, motivation letter and English certificate (optional, if any).

During the **second part of the selection procedure** (April-May, 2017) they will be interviewed and tested. A total of 94-100 participants from all members and neighbouring countries will be finally selected and will benefit from this training program.
